

# **Derby Safeguarding Adults Competency Framework**

**Purpose**: To support agencies in evidencing staff competence in Safeguarding Adults. Each agency identifies which staff belong to specific groups based on their roles and responsibilities.

## **Staff Group Competency Descriptions**

Staff Group A:

- Basic awareness and understanding of safeguarding duties.
- Mandatory for all employees working with adults.

#### Staff Group B:

- All staff working who are working with adults who are engaged in assessing, planning, delivering care and/or evaluating the needs of adults where there are safeguarding concerns
- Enhanced competency for staff involved in direct care or planning services for adults at risk.
- Requires understanding of safeguarding legislation and policies.

## Staff Group C:

- Advanced competencies for Specialist roles: safeguarding leads, named professionals, or those advising staff.
- Includes expertise in policy development, multi-agency collaboration, and complex case management.

#### Safeguarding Adulis Courses

All Course content is aligns with the *Adult Safeguarding: Roles and Competencies for Healthcare Staff 2024*). Module One is mapped to **Level 3 competency**, supporting staff who assess, plan, deliver or review care and who may identify or respond to safeguarding concerns. *Add hyperlink to the training Prospectus* 

All other courses are, designed to support the wider safeguarding workforce. They reinforce Level 3 safeguarding knowledge but are not restricted to a specific competency level.
