
Seen it?

People who have care and support needs may need to rely on others to help them in their dayto-day lives. As a result they may not be able to help themselves stay safe from other people.

Say "NO" to Abuse

What is Abuse?

Physical	Hitting, slapping or pushing
Emotional	Shouting, swearing, humiliating, threats or bullying
Sexual	Unwanted touching, kissing or sexual intercourse
Financial	Money or property being stolen or taken under pressure
Neglect	Not being looked after
Domestic Violence	Always being sad and being controlled
Sexual Exploitation	Unexplained bruising, change in behaviour
Self-Neglect	Not being able to look after yourself and personal health & safety is effected
Modern Day Slavery	Being controlled by others, not having own travel documents or personal things
